# Diploma of Project Management

## Course Description

The BSB51415 Diploma of Project Management caters for individuals who apply project management skills and knowledge in a work environment. They may manage projects in a variety of contexts, across a number of industry sectors, and are often employed as contractors or may be employees.

To maintain consistency across their organisation's operations, many employers require project managers to demonstrate an understanding of clearly defined internationally recognised project management process that are explained in this course. Industries with high WHS requirements may also list formal qualifications in project management as desirable when advertising vacant positions.

Learners may also include individuals who already have project leadership and management roles, and are responsible for achieving project objectives. You may have sound theoretical knowledge, use a range of specialised project management tools, and be looking to get technical and managerial competencies to initiate, plan, execute projects, and evaluate your own work or the work of others.

## Career Pathways

This course has no formal entry requirements, and may be suitable for applicants looking to enter a new industry or workplace, however the preferred pathways include:

- Previous project experience in any industry as an employee or contractor
- Work on informal projects that required organisational or planning skills
- Volunteer projects for a charity, sporting or community organisation

Possible career outcomes after completing the BSB51415 Diploma of Project Management may include:

- Department manager in large organisations
- Project manager

# Diploma of Project Management

## Course Delivery

Training and assessment will be conducted using a blended delivery model to cater for individual learning styles, which includes on-line resources, video and audio files, self-guided activities using the learning and assessment material supplied, and mentoring workshops.

In addition to the learning resources provided, each student will be assigned a mentor who will provide individual attention and support to assist students to progress through the course. The mentor will be able to contextualise assessments to a specific industry to improve your employment outcome options.

Prospective students may discuss with IGTS prior to enrolment the possibility of substituting other units that may be more relevant to their industry requirements. This discussion will also include possible recognition of prior learning (RPL) that could be applied to the course.

## Course Progression

If you decide to enrol in this course, your mentor will assess your training requirements, and advise you of the likely timeframe to complete this course. You may apply to extend your enrolment if your course is not completed in 12 months, or may also complete the required assessments to achieve competency in each unit ahead of the dates listed on your training plan, and shorten the duration of your course.
